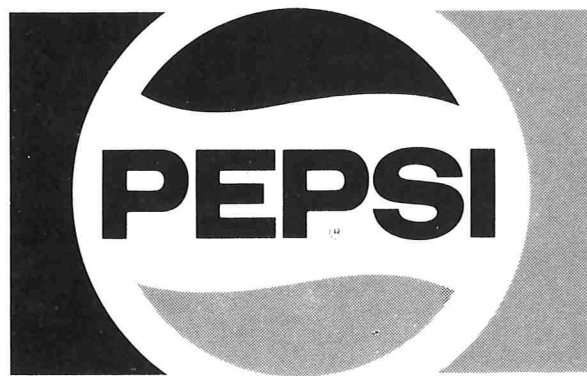

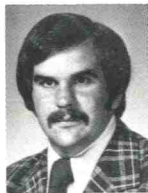

### Honorary Referee



JOHN S. GILL

John S. Gill of Elmhurst, retired Chicago Public League track coach and administrator, will be honored this weekend as Honorary Referee for the 82nd Illinois High School Association (IHSA) Boys State Track and Field Meet (here in Charleston) at O'Brien Field on the campus of Eastern Illinois University.

Gill retired May 15, 1974, after 38 years of teaching and coaching at Schurz and then Austin High Schools and serving as a supervisor in the Chicago Board of Education Central Office. From 1957 until his retirement, Gill administered the Public League boys track and field program and served on the IHSA Boys State Track Meet Games Committee.

Following graduation from St. Mel High School in Chicago, Gill attended the University of Illinois and was a member of the Fighting Illini track team. A hurdler, he was a member of the Illinois 320-yard high hurdle shuttle relay team which established a world record clocking of 40.5 seconds against Ohio State. Upon graduation from Illinois, he began his career in the Chicago school system in 1936 at LeMoyn School. Shortly after moving to Schurz, he enlisted in the U.S. Navy and earned the rank of Lieutenant, serving 57 months during World War II.

Gill returned to Austin after the war and within two years built a powerhouse track and field program that produced 16 Public League indoor and outdoor and cross country team titles in the next 10 years. He then became the Public League boys track administrator.

In 1966, he received the Chicago Junior Chamber of Commerce Award for Physical Fitness Leadership, and in 1974 he was a recipient of the University of Illinois "I" Men's Association award for service to the community and the university.
