Gene Armer Named Honorary Referee



GENE ARMER
Honorary Referee

Eugene (Gene) Armer, long-time Athletic Director for the Urbana Public School system, and a veteran coach and official in cross country and track, will serve this weekend as Honorary Referee for the 83rd Illinois High School Association (IHSAA) Boys State Track and Field Meet.

A 1929 graduate of Mattoon High School, Armer earned his Bachelor's Degree in 1935 at Eastern Illinois Univ., and his Master's in 1941 at the Univ. of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign. He began his coaching career at Humboldt High School in 1935, serving as basketball and track coach. After a four-year tour of duty in the U.S. Navy, he started a 28-year career in athletics at Urbana (H.S.), beginning in the 1945-46 school year as head wrestling coach (when his Tigers finished second by a point to Tilden Tech of Chicago in the 1946 State Final Meet). From 1946-1968 he was head track and cross country coach at Urbana and produced the record-setting 1951 harrier team which posted the lowest point total in the long history of the State Cross Country Meet at 21. And, from 1947 until his retirement at the conclusion of the 1972-73 school year, he was A.D. for the Urbana schools.

For the past nine years, Gene has been the Seeding Clerk of the Boys State Track Meet, and even longer has been the Head Timer for Univ. of Illinois Fighting Illini home meets. He will be the Head Timer for this year's NCAA Division I National Track Meet scheduled for June 2-4 at Memorial Stadium, Champaign. Three years ago, he served on the Games Committee of the NCAA Division II National Meet at EIU. For 17 of his 28 years at Urbana (H.S.), he was manager of the State Cross Country Meet.

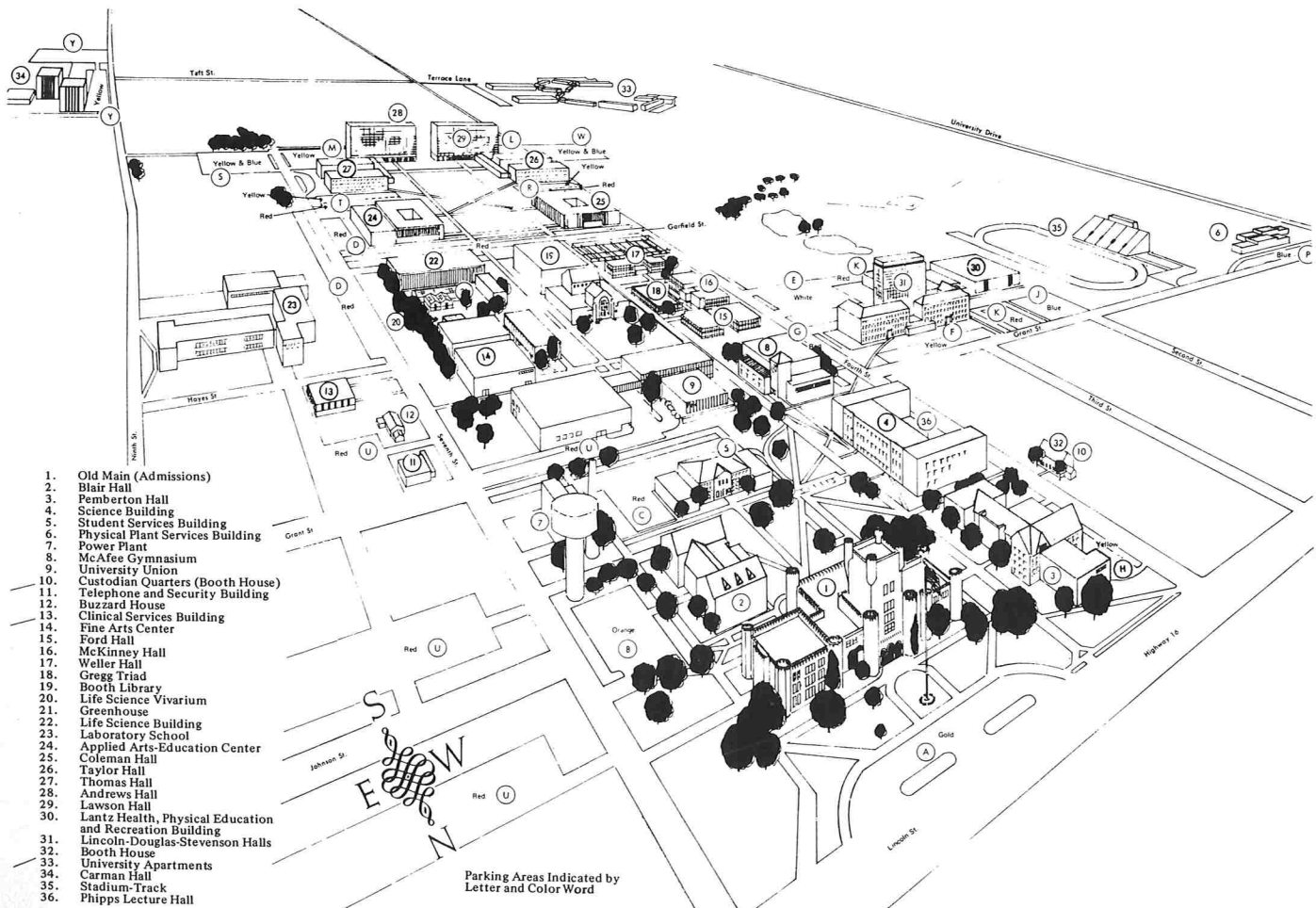

Illinois Tracksters

Set 4 National Marks

Of the 14 track and field national high school records for boys and girls approved recently by the National Federation of State High School Associations, Illinois athletes tied or established four.

Hurdler Greg Foster of Maywood (Proviso East) tied the national 120-yard hurdle mark with a clocking of 13.2 seconds in the 1976 IHSA Boys State Meet.

Hurdler Debi Kilhoffer of Illiopolis lowered the girls 110-yard mark to :13.9 from :14.2, while sprinter Brenda Gullede of Chicago (Calumet) set the girls 220-yard dash mark of :23.5. In addition, the Calumet 880-yard relay team of Annette Baxter, Angela Griffin, Linda Gullede and Brenda Gullede now holds that national mark with a 1:39.7 effort. All three marks were set in the 1976 IHSA Girls State Track Meet on the campus of Eastern Illinois Univ. last spring.

Oregon girls also bettered three national interscholastic records. Eryn Forbes of Sunset in Beaverton lowered the girls mile run to standard from 4:52.2 to 4:50.5; Kitsy Hall of Rogue River bettered the girls javelin mark by eight feet with a heave of 165 feet, 5 inches; and Centennial in Gresham established a new 880-yard medley relay mark of 1:47.3.

Texas girls broke two national records. Essie Kelley of Spur High School bettered her own 440-yard dash time of: 55.0 with a: 54.9 performance; and the 440-yard relay team of Trimble Tech in Fort Worth set a new record in that event with a: 46.8 performance, eclipsing the old mark of: 47.1 held by Columbia of West Columbia, Texas.

Janet Lee Beall of Germantown, Tennessee, was timed in: 10.2 in the 80-yard hurdles last season to better the record of: 10.4. Hilary Noden of Hopewell Valley in Dennington, New Jersey, shaved nearly a half minute off the two-mile run record. Her time of 10:41.9 eclipsed the mark of 11:11.6. Kathy McMillan of Hoke County in Raeford, North Carolina, surpassed the long jump mark by nearly two feet when she leaped 22-1 $\frac{3}{4}$. The old mark was 20-4, set in 1975.

Dwayne Evans, the olympian from South Mountain High School in Phoenix, Arizona, established a new 220-yard dash mark for boys running on a curve with a: 20.5 clocking. This bettered the oldest record in boys track and field. The previous mark of: 20.6 was established by Melvin Clipper of Muir in Pasadena, California in 1958.
