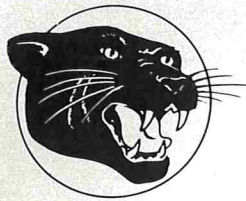

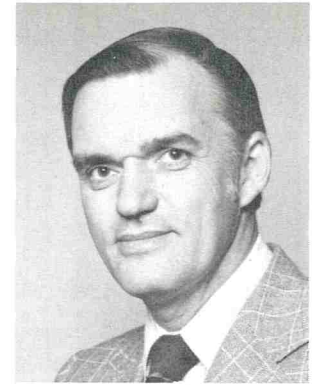
# Greetings to Participants, Officials, and Spectators

The man who the experts call "Mr. Track in Illinois", Roy Gummerson of Oak Park, has been named Honorary Referee for the 84th Illinois High School Association (IHSAA) Boys State Track and Field Meet this weekend. He will be honored Saturday here at O'Brien Stadium.

## Roy Gummerson Named Honorary Referee

Chairman of the Boys Track and Field Advisory Committee and chairman of the Games Committee for the past dozen years, Gummerson retired from teaching and coaching last June completing a 41-year career which included one year at Kinderhook High School (1936), 17 years at Peoria (Woodruff) (1937-54) and 22 years at Oak Park-River Forest (1955-77). He is the third man from Oak Park to be so honored, joining track and field immortals Robert S. Woodruff and Ross Anderson.



ROY GUMMERSON  
Oak Park

A business and mathematics teacher by profession, but one of the most successful and astute track and field coaches and meet administrators in the nation by desire, Gummerson began his coaching career handling football, basketball and baseball at Kinderhook. When he moved to Woodruff, he assumed the duties in track and cross country and guided Woodruff to the 1952 state harrier title and the runnerup spot in 1954. He coached track and cross country at Oak Park-River Forest. His harrier teams finished in the top five in the State Meet 12 times. Yet, he is renowned for his administration of the annual Oak Park Relays and the Boys State High School Meet.

Noted the 1977 Oak Park yearbook (Tabula) in the first paragraph of a special article devoted to him and veteran Robert Wehrli, who retired as head of the Physical Education department: "Some teachers should retire after one year, but teachers like Mr. Gummerson should not retire at all." He received a standing ovation from the student body when he was introduced at the 1977 Fall Sports Awards Assembly.

Gummerson's track career did not begin until his junior year in high school, but his talent in running blossomed when he became a standout at Bradley Univ., Peoria.

His son, Ron, is track and cross country coach at Hoffman Estates (Conant).

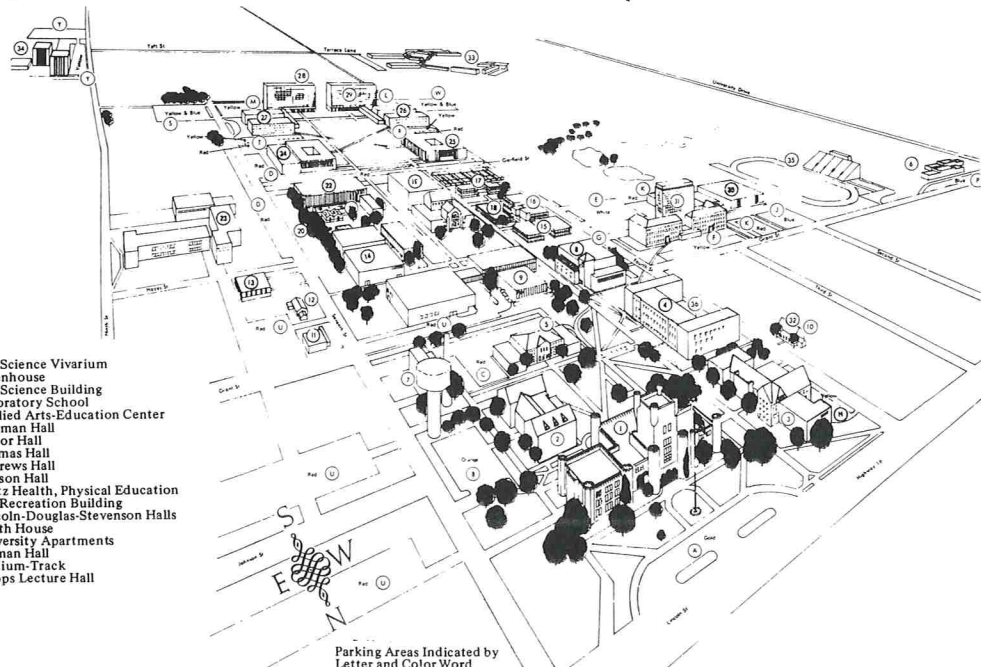
