

Redbirds slip to 11th in Weibring tourney

NORMAL — The home course didn't prove to be much of an advantage for Illinois State's men's golfers in the final round of the D.A. Weibring Intercollegiate at the ISU Golf Course.

The Redbirds fired a final-round 295 Tuesday and dropped from second to fifth in the 15-team field.

Southwest Missouri State shot 286 for an 859 total and held off Northern Iowa, which fired a tourney-low 281 to finish at 861. Drake (866) and St. Louis (873) took third and fourth, respectively.

Freshman Kris Wildenradt paced

ISU with a 74-216 to tie for 10th place, followed by sophomore Kyle Vasel (71-217) and freshman Chris Eddy (75-218). ISU's Matt Maskel, playing as an individual, tied with Wildenradt (71-216). Another Redbird individual, Denny Bull, had the team's best round Tuesday with a 2-under-par 69 and tied Vasel for 14th.

Northern Iowa's Marc Cahalan earned medalist honors, shooting 70 Tuesday for a 4-under-par 209 total. That was two strokes ahead of Evansville's Jason Reddington, while Northern Iowa's Mike Lewis shot the tourney's low round at 67 to finish third at 212.
