## Teams advance to State

Boys clinch Sectional title; girls place 5th at Normal U-High

The Mahomet-Seymour boys' cross country team continued to run past its competitors to win its fifth straight IHSA Class 2A Sectional title at Normal University Saturday.

"Despite the horrible cold, wind, and rain the team ran a strong race," said coach Neal Garrison. "They represented our team and school

well."

Alex Keeble was the runner-up with a time of 15:24.4.

Keeble, Gabe Pommier (15:39.4), and Brian Butcher (15:40.1) earned All-Sectional honors by placing in the top 10. Pommier finished eighth and Butcher placed tenth.

"We have only had 15 runners earn All-Sectional honors in our 46-year history," said Garrison. "This is the first time we have had three runners in the same year accomplish this feat."
